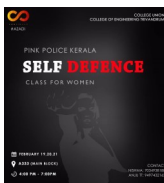

6th August 2017.

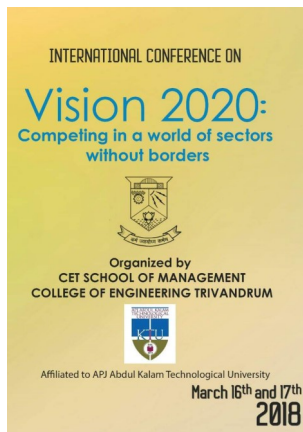


InnovExpo'17
