Guidelines for students taking temporary accommodation at the Mens' Hostel, CET, for attending contact classes

Students who are given temporary allotment in the hostel are hereby instructed to adhere to the following guidelines during their stay in the hostel

- 1. Only Students who are in possession of RT-PCR negative certificate taken 48 hours before arrival will be allowed inside the Mens' Hostel.
- 2. Students should wear masks, maintain social distancing norms and follow all guidelines issued by the Government of India, Government of Kerala, the University, the College and Hostel authorities during their period of stay and also outside office hours/college timing.
- 3. Students who are having any symptomatic diseases during their stay such as fever (feeling hot to the touch, a temperature of 37.8 degrees Celsius or higher), new onset of cough (continuous, more than usual), difficulty in breathing or shortness of breath (out of breath, unable to breathe deeply), sore throat, difficulty in swallowing or hoarse voice (more rough or harsh than normal), chills, runny, stuffy or congested nose, lost sense of taste or smell, persistent headache, digestive issues (nausea/vomiting, diarrheas, stomach pain), fatigue (lack of energy, extreme tiredness) or falling down more than usual should report immediately to the sergeant/hostel authorities.
- 4. Only temporary admission is given to students for attending contact classes. Therefore, all inmates are strictly directed to vacate the hostel on the date of expiring of the temporary accommodation.
- 5. All inmates should record their entry and exit from the Mens' hostel in the movement register without fail to enable authorities to observe that Covid 19 protocols are respected.
- 6. Students are required to wash their hands and sanitize properly before entering the hostel as well as at regular intervals.
- 7. If rooms allocated to students contain the belongings of other students, the newly occupying students

should not indulge in any activities that can disturb/tamper/or take the belongings of other students kept in the room allotted. Students are responsible for the security of the same and have to reimburse the actual cost in case of any liabilities incurred during the stay due to any damages/tampering.

- 8. No outside food is permitted for students during the duration of stay at the Mens' hostel.
- 9. There should be no crowding in recreation rooms, dining halls, corridors and other common amenities keeping in view the requirement of physical distancing and other covid protocol measures.
- 10. Cleanliness should be strictly maintained and wastes should be disposed off, in specialised bins meant for the purpose
- 11. Students are required to produce the declaration form (provided on the College Website) duly filled by the parent and students on their arrival at the Mens' hostel.

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
