Eligibility Criteria for Candidates

- I. Under graduate students between the ages of 17 and 23 may contest elections (Maximum age is 24 for B.Arch students)
- II. For Post Graduate Students the maximum age limit to contest the election would be 25 years. (Maximum age is 26 for M.Arch students)
- III. For research Students the maximum age limit to contest an election would be 29 years.
 - IV. The candidate should have attained the minimum 75% attendance,
 - V. The candidate should in no event have any academic arrears in the year of contesting the election.
 - VI. The candidate shall have one opportunity to contest for the post of office bearer, and two opportunities to contest for the post of an executive member.
- VII. The candidate shall not have a previous criminal record, that is to say he should not have been tried and/or convicted of any criminal offence or misdemeanor. The candidate shall also not have been subject to any disciplinary action by the University authorities.
