Hostel Allotment Criteria

Ref: GO(Rt)No. 1491/2021/HEDN dated Thiruvananthapuram, 10/11/2021

- A. Students in CET belonging to SC/ST/BPL/PH/Outside Kerala/Government of India Nominee shall be provided Hostel Accommodation regardless of their Branch (including MBA) and year of admission. They can take their seats in the Ladies/Mens' hostel after paying the required fee (see from CET website). Also see the guidelines to know what else is required to take your seat. As a special case, second year students in these categories with a certificate from a competent authority defining the category are permitted to occupy their seats in the Hostel even before making payment.

- B. Based on the GO referred, rank list of the applicants shall be prepared based on academic merit and annual income with 50% weightage to each. In case of candidates with same score, the preference will be based on the following.
 - a. Candidate with lower annual income.
 - b. Candidate with early Date of Birth.
 - c. Alphabetic order of the name.

- B. Academic merit of students of various courses will be evaluated based on the details given below.
 - 1. B.Tech
 - a. 1st year – KEAM Rank
 - b. 2nd year – SGPA of S1
 - c. 3rd year – SGPA of S3
 - d. 4th year – Average of SGPAs of S3,S4 & S5

 - 2. B.Arch
 - a. 1st year – Rank in the list published by CEE
 - b. 2nd year – SGPA of S1

- c. 3rd year – Average of SGPA of previous semesters
- d. 4th year – Average of SGPA of previous semesters

3. PG

- a. 1st year – Rank in the Rank list published by DTE
- b. 2nd year - Rank in the Rank list published by DTE

4. MCA

- a. 1st year – Entrance Rank
- b. 2nd year - Entrance Rank / Average of SGPA of previous semesters
