ORDER

Numerous requests were being received for extending the benefit of Inter college Transfer to some more category of B.Tech students in the affiliated colleges of the University Upon examining the same it was observed the existing B.Tech Regulations needs modification to give benefit of inter college transfer to more students.

Vide paper read as (2) above, a subcommittee of the SSC on Academics and research was constituted to propose modifications of inter college transfer regulations, based on the resolution of the 11th meeting of syndicate standing committee on Academics and Research, read as paper (1) above.

Vide paper read as (3) above, draft Regulation of inter college transfer of the regular B.Tech students studying at colleges affiliated to the University was submitted by the subcommittee of the SSC on Academics and Research and it was placed before the SSC on Academics and Research for consideration and the SSC on Academics and Research recommended some modifications to the Regulations and the modified draft regulations was placed before the Syndicate for approval.

Vide paper read as (4) above, the 36th meeting of Syndicate resolved to approve the revised regulations for inter college transfer for regular B.Tech students studying in colleges affiliated to APJ Abdul Kalam Technological University as recommended by the SSC on Academics and Research.

Sanction has been accorded by the Vice Chancellor, to approve the above recommendation of the Syndicate to modify the Regulations for Inter College Transfer of B.Tech 2019, by invoking powers vested under clause 14(5) of the APJAKTU Act 2015, subject to ratification by the Board of Governors. The modified Regulations are appended herewith.



The clauses under Para 9 of B.Tech Regulations 2019 stands modified to the above extent

Regulations for Inter College Transfer for Regular B. Tech Students Studying in Colleges Affiliated to APJ Abdul Kalam Technological University - Proposal

I SHORT TITLE

- I.1 These regulations shall be called “**APJ Abdul Kalam Technological University Regulations for Inter College Transfer of Regular B. Tech (2019 Scheme).**”

II SCOPE

- II.1 The Regulations provided herein shall apply for regular B. Tech students studying in the colleges affiliated to APJ Abdul Kalam Technological University.
- II.2 The provisions herein supersede all the existing Regulations for Inter College Transfer of regular B. Tech students studying in the colleges affiliated to APJ Abdul Kalam Technological University.

III DEFINITIONS

- III.1 “**University**” means APJ Abdul Kalam Technological University, Kerala
- III.2 “**College**” means the college affiliated to APJ Abdul Kalam Technological University, Kerala.
- III.3 “**Category**” means the category to which the student admitted in the college.
- III.4 “**Academic eligibility**” means the academic eligibility requirements prescribed in the relevant prospectus for the B. Tech admission

IV REGULATIONS

- IV.1 Inter college transfer shall be applicable only for regular B. Tech students.
- IV.2 The transfer shall be permitted just before the commencement of third semester.
- IV.3 The transfer shall be with effect from the first working day of the third semester.
- IV.4 The transfer shall be only within the sanctioned strength of the receiving college.
- IV.5 The following Category of students **shall not be eligible** for inter college transfer



- a. Govt. of India Nominee.
 - e. Lateral Entry Students.
 - f. Students admitted under TFW scheme.
 - g. Students admitted in any supernumerary seats (Eg. EWS)
 - h. Students of Autonomous Institutions
 - i. Any other category which are ineligible as per conditions for admission prescribed by Govt. of Kerala/ Govt of India.
- IV.6 The transfer shall be permitted only between:
- 1. Between Govt/ Govt. Aided Colleges (merit seats)
 - 2. Between Govt Controlled Self – Financing Colleges(merit seats)
 - 3. Between Private Self Financing Colleges(merit seats)
 - 4. Between Management quota seats in Aided Colleges
 - 5. Between Management quota in Private Self Financing Colleges
 - 6. Between Students admitted under NRI/PIO quota in Aided Colleges
 - 7. Between Students admitted under NRI/PIO quota in Self-financing Colleges
- (No Transfer is permitted for students to and from Autonomous Institutions.)
- IV.7 Notification inviting application for inter college transfer shall be issued by the University just before the commencement of the third semester.
- IV.8 The candidate should fulfil the academic eligibility requirements for promotion to third semester.
- IV.9 If the number of applicants is more than the vacant seat available in the receiving college, the transfer shall be based on the rank obtained by the applicant in the KEAM Entrance Examinations.
- IV.10 The student shall opt only one college for inter college transfer.
- IV.11 The candidates recommended by the Principal of the receiving college shall remit fee of Rs. 3000/- (No fee for SC/ST Students) to the University Account through portal within the stipulated date, to process the application. However, this rule is not applicable to the students transferred to other institutions under “Shift College” by University order.
- IV.12 The College Transfer once approved by the University upon the recommendation of the Principal of the receiving college in the portal, subject to the conditions stipulated in the



regulations, will be final and binding on the applicant. No student will be permitted, under any circumstances, to refuse the change of college once approved by the University.

- IV.13 Notwithstanding anything contained in the above regulations, if there are reasonable grounds for the University to believe that there is an emergency which requires immediate action to be taken, or if any action is required to be taken in the interest of the University or in the interest of the welfare of the students, the Syndicate shall take such action.
