542 21/10/2022	Regarding rules for hostel admission, the Council had decided that those who are within a distance of 20 kilometres from CET are not eligible to get included in the rank list for hostel admission. However, those who need special consideration can approach the Principal through proper channel (Advisor -> HOD -> Principal) and the Principal may or may not permit such students to get included in the rank list for hostel admission, based on the reason for getting special consideration.  The Council has discussed the concerns represented by a student organisation about the way the Council previously decided to fill the seats earmarked for the reserved categories. As per the GO, all students admitted under the categories - Government of India Nominees and Outside Kerala students (based on nativity certificate) should be given hostel admission. AICTE's financial support is obtained to construct a part of the Ladies Hostel for accommodating students belonging to SC and ST categories. Using this fund, facilities for 75 seats are constructed and hence 75 seats in the LH should be earmarked exclusively for students belonging to SC and ST categories. Based on the recent order from the Government of Kerala, from the remaining seats, 30% of the seats have to be earmarked exclusively for students from the categories BPL, PH, SC and ST and the remaining seats (that is 70%) have to be divided to UG and PG students in the ratio 9:1. Accordingly, the council has decided the seat positions in LH and MH and are shown as Annexures A and B attached. It is also found as per the GO that 30% seats earmarked for BPL, PH, SC and ST categories can be allotted by considering all such students as a single group regardless of their category (BPL, PH, SC or ST) and programme/course of study.
